Resetting a PanelView Plus Version 6 or greater to factory default state

Question

How to reset a PanelView Plus Version 6 or greater to factory default state? This might be desirable after a failed firmware update, for example.

Why does my PanelView Plus Version 6 or greater show the computer OS when powering up, with no Rockwell Software showing under *Window Startup --> Program*?

Answer

Note*: Requires an attached USB keyboard prior to accessing Maintenance mode.

All user updates will be removed including user installed firmware updates and patches. All .MER files will be deleted.

- 1. On PanelView Plus 6 models (firmware v6.x and greater), there is a small, recessed button labeled **DEFAULT** into which you can insert a thin non-conductive probe. This will restart the terminal in Maintenance mode.
 - Note*: To access this menu from a fault state, press the Reset switch, then press and hold the Default switch until you see the menu.
